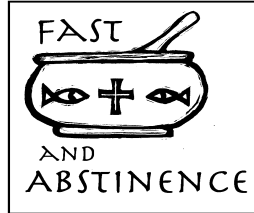

**LENTEN FAST & ABSTINENCE**

Abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law. Also, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, meaning, take no solid food between meals and only one full meal that day. Serious reasons, such as one's health can excuse a person from these Lenten obligations.

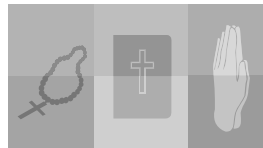

**HOLY WEEK**

**CHRISM MASS Monday - March 26th**

The Chrism Mass will be held at the Cathedral in Providence at 5:00PM.

The Chrism Mass is a celebration of the priesthood of Christ. Since we all share in this priesthood by virtue of our baptism, all of us are encouraged to attend and to pray with and for our clergy as they recommit themselves to their vocation.

**Holy Thursday - March 29th - 7:00PM**

The Mass of the Lord's Supper followed by Adoration.

The Holy Oils, blessed by the Bishop, are brought into the Church during this liturgy. We begin our celebration of the Lord's Passion by joining Jesus and his disciples at the Last Supper. This liturgy includes washing the feet of 12 parishioners representing the apostles. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will follow until 11:00 PM.
