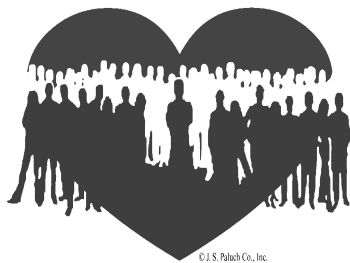

THE CALM BEFORE THE STORM
